SCHOOL

Advantages School International offers a comprehensive four-year curriculum serving over 1,000 students in grades Kindergarten through twelve. ASI is an online school which was established in 2007. The school is accredited by AdvancED, NCAA and Northwest Accreditation Commission; it also holds membership in The College Board. ASI is continuously listed on America's Best Online Schools

THE CURRICULUM

ASI has two graduation tracks. For students planning to attend a post-secondary institution, they must complete our College Preparatory requirements. Our General Education track is for students looking for a high school diploma without anticipating college.

For a **College Preparatory** track, a minimum of 20 credits is required for graduation. .5 credit = 1 semester, 1 credit = 1 year. 2018-2019 CP graduation includes the following credit requirements: English (4); mathematics (4); science (3); social science (3) including US History (.5), US Government (.5); Physical Education (1.5); Health (.5); Visual and Performing Arts (1); World Languages (2); Elective (1). For a **General Education** track, a minimum of 13 credits is required for graduation. 2018-2019 GE graduation includes the following credit requirements: English (3); mathematics (2); science (2); social science (3) including US History (.5), US Government (.5); Physical Education (1.5); Health (.5); Visual and Performing Arts (1)

Advanced Placement course are offered in English Language, English Literature, Biology, chemistry, Environmental Science, Psychology, Calculus AB, Statistics, US History, US Government and Politics, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Spanish Language.

Honors courses are offered in the subject areas of English 9, 10, 11 and 12, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Geography and World Cultures, World History, World History to the Renaissance, US History, US History to the Civil War, US History since the Civil War, and US and Global Economics.



GRADING AND RANKING

Advantages School International assigns letter grades using a 4.0 system and has adopted the following grading scale: A=94-100%; A-=90-93%; B+=87-89%; B=84-86%; B-=80-83%; C+=77-79%; C=73-76%; C-=70-72%; D+=67-69%; D=63-66%; D-=60-62%; F=0-59%.
